The International Year of Pulses (www.iyp2016.org) will be celebrated on 7 October at the Italian Chamber of Deputies with a meeting organized in cooperation with a number of Italian research institutes. The United Nations declared 2016 the International Year of Pulses. Pulse crops, such as beans, chickpeas and lentils, are an important low-fat source of proteins, fibres and vitamins. These crops play a key role in contributing to food security and promoting sustainable agriculture, thus reducing greenhouse gas emissions and mitigating climate changes. Moreover, pulses are the key to a healthy diet and help prevent serious diseases.

In Europe, today as in the past, pulses are a central part of farmers' diet; in poorest and disadvantaged countries they are the main source of proteins and an important source of other nutrients, such as vitamins and minerals for rural populations in developing countries. Beans, chickpeas and other pulses are indispensable elements of a sustainable agriculture that contributes to increasing soil fertility and are a possible valuable source of non-animal proteins that have a beneficial impact on health.

This meeting will provide the opportunity to present development and research initiatives on pulses at a national and international level, with special reference to the research project BEAN_ADAPT, coordinated by the Polytechnic University of Marche, aimed at identifying the genes in common bean that are responsible for adaptation to new environments. BEAN_ADAPT proposes to make available technologies and germplasm directly to seed companies and farmers, so as to implement efficient plant breeding programmes and contribute to a multilateral system to access and share in the benefits deriving from research and the use of genetic resources.
