Call for scholarships for Ukrainian students or students enrolled in a Ukrainian University Academic Year 2022/2023

Art. 1 - OBJECT

Università Politecnica delle Marche (UNIVPM) is offering n. 10 scholarships to Ukrainian students or students enrolled in a Ukrainian University forced to flee the conflict in Ukraine and willing to continue their training by enrolling in a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or single courses or by carrying out a traineeship at Università Politecnica delle Marche in the a.y. 2022/2023.

Each scholarship amounts to € 500,00 per month, gross of all charges for the beneficiary's account. Scholarship holders will also benefit from a tuition fee waiver, including the regional tax.

Art. 2 - INCOMPATIBILITY

The scholarships awarded under this Call are incompatible with any scholarships offered by regional authorities (such as ERDIS), Università Politecnica delle Marche and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI).

Art. 3 - APPLICATIONS

Applications shall be submitted by filling in the application form called "Scholarships for Ukrainian students Application" published at the following link: https://www.univpm.it/Entra/Internazionale/Offerta formativa internazionale/Opportunita per studenti stranieri - Riepilogo/L/1.

The abovementioned application form, together with a valid ID document, must be sent to international@univpm.it, using the following e-mail subject: "Scholarships for Ukrainian students Application".

It is strongly recommended to also send the following documents, if owned, which might be essential to evaluate the student's application:

Curriculum vitae;

Motivation letter;

Transcript of academic records;

High School diploma or Bachelor's/Master's degree certificate;

Certificate of enrollment in a Ukrainian University;

Document stating the international protection/refugee status;

English or Italian* language proficiency certificate (depending on the selected course).



The deadline for the submission of the applications is set on 24 August 2022 at 1.00 p.m. CET.

*In order to enrol in an Italian taught course, students will have to prove a B2 level in Italian (according to the CEFR) by either providing an Italian language proficiency certificate or by taking an Italian language test organized by Univpm. Find more information on procedures and exemptions here.

Art. 4 – AWARD CRITERIA

Eligibility for enrollment in the chosen course/traineeship; International protection/refugee status; Evaluation of the application by the Committee for Internationalization of UNIVPM.

ART. 5 – SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

Payments will be subject to administrative and academic requirements.

The payment of the first installment is subject to the student's actual arrival at Università Politecnica delle Marche and to his/her enrolment.
