Nomination procedure	The home university shall nominate their students through an email sent to exchange.students@unican.es 15 th of May for Autumn semester (1 st semester) and full academic year 1 st of October for Spring semester (2 nd semester)			
Application deadline	For Autumn semester (1 st semester) and full academic year: 1 st of June For Spring semester (2 nd semester): 15 th of October			
Letter of Acceptance	After processing the application, a Letter of Acceptance will be sent via email to the student along with the signed learning agreement. The receiving institution will send its decision within 5 weeks.			
Orientation / Welcome Program	A 3-day Orientation Program is held before the beginning of each semester. An orientation session and day-trips are organized to welcome new students and facilitate their integration.
