Enrolment Criteria for Exchange	Maximum 42,0 ECTS per each Semester
Students	• Submission of "Changes to the Learning Agreement" only available until the 4 th week of the starting day of classes. Changes only allowed once, without exceeding the enrolment limits.
	 Some of the optional subjects may have limited places/vacancies. We cannot guarantee availability for all students.
	• Optional subjects will be offered/lectured if the minimum number of enrolled students is met (10 students).
	• Schedules are usually only available near the starting day of each semester.
	• Courses from 1 st Year/ 1 st Cycle are <u>not advisable</u> .
Language Requirements	Main/Official teaching language is Portuguese.
	However, a minimum of English knowledge is also necessary, because some of the study materials and other relevant information may be available/provided by the Professors in this language.
	No Portuguese language certification is requested for the application.
Educational language for Exchange Students	Students can enroll in a beginner's Portuguese Language Course offered by ICLP, also from the University of Lisbon, The course costs around $75 \in$ and has a duration of 50 hours (6ECTS). Nominated students will be informed by email when the application period is open. The course has limited vacancies.
Accommodation	Most of the students will have to find their own private accommodation in the city of Lisbon.
