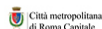

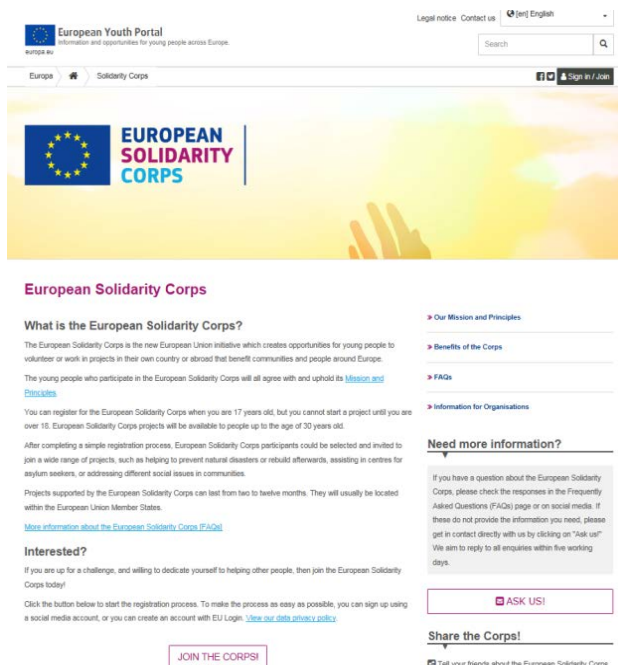

MEASURES	BENEFITS
Contribution to the travel and subsistence costs related to Job Interview	From EUR 100 to EUR 600 , according to distance and duration
Contribution to the costs related to Country relocation	From EUR 700 to EUR 1.400 , according to country of destination
Contribution to the costs incurred with Language course	Actual declared costs - up to EUR 1.500
Contribution to the costs incurred with Recognition of qualifications	EUR 400 (flate-rate)
Supplementary allowance for young people with special needs (Specific mobility needs)	Reimbursement of eligible declared costs - up to EUR 1.000 per trip
Subsistence allowance for recruited trainees only	Complementary fee - up to EUR 600 /month (max 6 months)
Reimbursement of Return travel costs	Actual declared costs
