<u>Scientific Research Activities:</u> The selected researcher will be required to conduct research activities within their specific scientific-disciplinary sector.

<u>Teaching Activities:</u> The teaching activities, including supplementary teaching and student tutoring, will amount to 350 annual hours, of which 120 annual hours (full-time) are dedicated to frontal teaching activities. The frontal teaching activities will be assigned annually according to the discipline of the Regulations on the teaching duties of professors and researchers. The teaching activities will be carried out within the framework of the educational programming of the three-year undergraduate degrees, single-cycle master's degrees, and master's degrees of the University and consist of conducting lectures, practical exercises, and theoretical-practical activities, assisting with examinations, and in any teaching assignments given as an institutional duty, in accordance with the provisions and within the limits of the law. The teaching activities will be carried out with reference to the belonging scientific-disciplinary sector of (MED/12) Gastroenterology.

<u>Assistance Activities:</u> The assistance activities will be directed towards the clinical and endoscopic management of patients with chronic gastroenterological diseases in a Day Hospital regime, outpatient clinics, and ward.
