

## **Tuition fee regulations for academic year 2023/2024**

### **Art. 1 - Scope**

These regulations establish the criteria for the 2023/2024 academic year to determine the tuition fees payable by those who have enrolled full time / part-time in bachelor's degrees, master's degrees and post-graduate courses at the Università Politecnica delle Marche,, in addition to the criteria for any exemptions and/or reductions.

The Università Politecnica delle Marche is guided by general principles of equity and solidarity in relation to financial conditions, adopting appropriate methods to ensure effective progressivity, also with the objective of protecting those in financial difficulty.

### **Art. 2 Composition of fees and contributions**

The fees and contributions consist of:

- Stamp duty (€ 16.00)
- Regional tax for the right to university education (€ 140.00)
- Annual all-inclusive fee, which varies according to:
  - the student's financial situation and the composition of the student's household as per the ISEE certificate (Equivalent Economic Status Indicator) for financial benefits for the right to university education
  - the chosen course.

In addition, surcharges may be applicable for services provided for individual needs, subject to a specific request.

### **Art. 3 Calculation of the all-inclusive fee**

The all-inclusive contribution **(CO)** payable is calculated on the basis of the personal value of the ISEE certificate **(A)** valid for financial benefits for the right to university education as per the following algorithm and with the variables shown in the tables below:

$$CO = [B + (A - C) * D] * E$$

A bracket is assigned at the outset, on the basis of the ISEE certificate, ranging from the minimum and maximum limits of each bracket.

The amount of the all-inclusive fee is rounded up to the nearest Euro.

#### **Art. 4 Fee for students with foreign financial situations**

Those residing in EU and non EU countries, and Italian students residing abroad, or with foreign income and assets, may only apply for the equivalent ISEE certificate from one of the CAFs (Tax Assistance Centres) affiliated with the University.

If the equivalent ISEE certificate is not presented, the maximum contribution adjusted to the course coefficient will be applicable, except for non-EU citizens who are not Italian residents where:

- for citizens of a developing country, as indicated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in an annual list, an ISEE of € 13,001 is conventionally considered;
- for citizens from non-developing countries, an ISEE of €24,000 is conventionally considered.

#### **Art. 5 Fee for part-time enrollment**

For part-time enrollment, i.e. for those who opt for a course duration which is longer than the standard duration of the course, the all-inclusive fee established as per the procedures set out in Art. 3 is reduced by 50% with respect to that applicable to those who enroll full-time.

## **Art. 6 Fee for interruption of studies**

Those who interrupt their studies for less than two academic years are required to pay an all-inclusive fee equal to the maximum amount payable for bracket 2 (F2), adjusted according to the course coefficient.

For those in possession of an ISEE certificate lower than the amount determined above, the fee payable will be proportional to the ISEE.

If the period of interruption of studies is equal to or greater than two academic years, students are required to pay a "recognition fee" for each year of interruption (the amount of which is indicated in Art. 21), in addition to fees and duty outstanding for the academic year that students resume their studies.

## **Art. 7 Methods and time-frame for submitting ISEE certificates**

To determine the all-inclusive fee, those who enrol must access their ESSE 3 WEB personal area, between the first day of enrollment and 6 November 2023. They must follow the guided procedure by which they grant their consent to authorize the University to directly acquire the ISEE indicator from the INPS database. This consent is valid for their entire university career, unless it is specifically revoked from within the student's personal area.

Applications for the ISEE certificate valid for the right to university education must be submitted by the aforementioned deadline. Subsequent to the deadline, and in any case, prior to the expiry of the third installment, it is possible to apply for recalculation by presenting the ISEE certificate, but a late fee will be applied, as per Art. 20.

In the event that the University is not given consent to acquire the ISEE certificate from the INPS database, the all-inclusive fee that is payable will be the maximum one, adjusted according to the course coefficient.

The ISEE indicator for determining the all-inclusive fee is the only valid indicator for financial benefit for the right to university education, without omissions and/or discrepancies.

All benefits foreseen in this Regulation are granted only subject to a specific application and using the appropriate forms for reductions/exemptions. Application forms must be submitted by the aforementioned deadline.

The fees can be seen in students' personal areas and there is a period of 15 days to report any issues.

## **Art. 8 Payment methods and terms**

The payment of fees and taxes is divided into three installments.

The first installment amounts to €156.00 (including €140.00 regional tax for the right to university education and €16.00 stamp duty).

This amount must be paid upon initial enrollment or registration for years subsequent to the first. The deadline for the first installment is 6th November 2023.

For enrollment in restricted access courses, the first installment must be paid within the time limits indicated in the individual calls for admission to such courses.

The second and third installments, which amount to the same sum, must be paid by 14th December 2023 and 31st May 2024 respectively.

If the second installment is less than €20.00, this amount will be merged with the third installment. Late enrollments will have a single invoice including the second and third installments due on 31st May 2024.

Payments made subsequent to these deadlines will be subject to the penalty fee as per Art. 20. All payments must be made exclusively via the PagoPA system.

## **Art. 9 Exemptions**

### **1. Beneficiaries eligible for the regional scholarship (as per legislative decree 68/2012)**

Those registering in years subsequent to the first and who are beneficiaries of, or who are eligible for regional scholarships (ERDIS), are exempt from paying both the all-inclusive fee, determined pursuant to Art 3, and the regional tax for the right to university education.

### **2. No tax area**

The all-inclusive fee as per Art. 3 will be waived for the following individuals, who will only be liable for the payment of stamp duty and regional tax:

- students enrolling in the University in their first academic year with an ISEE certificate of less than or equal to €25,000,00;
- students registering in years subsequent to the first who are members of a household with an ISEE of less than or equal to €25,000.00 who meet both the following requirements:
  - a) they have been students at the Università Politecnica delle Marche for a number of academic years which is less than or equal to the normal course duration plus one;
  - b) second year students must have achieved at least 10 university credits (CFU/ECTS) by 10th August of their first year. Students registered in academic years subsequent to the second year, must have achieved at least 25 credits during the 12 month period prior to 10th August preceding their registration.

For part-time registration, the necessary credits are reduced to 5 and 12 respectively.

For 3rd year students registered in the Medicine and Surgery course, it is sufficient to have acquired 18 credits in the twelve months prior to August 10th preceding the relative registration.

### **3. Other exemptions**

Exemption from paying the all-inclusive fee and the regional tax will be applicable to the following individuals who therefore will only be liable to pay of stamp duty:

- a) those who have a recognised handicap in accordance with art. 3 paragraph 1, of Law 104/1992, or a recognised invalidity equal to or greater than 66%, as provided for by art 9 paragraph 2 of legislative Decree 68/2012. This exemption is for a maximum period not exceeding three times the legal duration of the course for each level.

There is also an exemption from paying the all-inclusive fee and therefore only the stamp duty and the regional tax are payable for:

- b) children of invalidity pension holders, in accordance with Law 118/1971.
- c) Italian Government (MAECI) scholarship holders for areas of development cooperation programs and intergovernmental cultural and scientific agreements and relative periodic implementation programs. In the years subsequent to the first, the exemption is subject to the renewal of the scholarship by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Exemption is granted only for a time period equal to the legal duration of the course plus one year.
- d) Those receiving international protection (Legislative Decree 19/11/2007 no. 251), subject to presentation of supporting documents.
- e) Those enrolled at the University in the first year of a single cycle bachelor's or master's degree course who obtained a secondary school certificate with a mark of 100 cum laude from any institution within the national territory.

- f) Those enrolled at the University, in the first year of a two-year Master's degree course, who obtained a Bachelor's degree with 110 cum laude from any university within the national territory.

#### Exemptions for merit

- g) those who, by the 10th August prior to their registration, have acquired the maximum number of credits attainable by that date with an average of no less than the minimum requirement for access to this benefit referring to each individual course. For these particularly deserving students, this support will vary over 5 equal percentile bands according to the average achieved, while guaranteeing an exemption of at least 20% of the all-inclusive fee as determined in Art. 3.
- h) those who are enrolled in Bachelor's degree courses of national or community interest (Civil and Environmental Engineering, Electronic Engineering, Biomedical Engineering, Computer and Automation Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Management Engineering), who by the 10th August prior to their enrollment have acquired 80% of the maximum number of credits achievable by this date with an average of no less than the minimum requirement to have access to the support.  
This support will vary over 5 equal percentile bands according to the average achieved, while guaranteeing an exemption of at least 20% of the all-inclusive fee as determined in Art. 3. The aforementioned percentage of 80% may be subject to revision, either by reduction or increase, up to the maximum capacity of the ministerial financing acquired.

In both cases, the merit requirements necessary for getting this support are assessed with reference to the "Table of Merit" (Annex D).

The reference year shown in the aforementioned table corresponds to the year of entry into the University; except for those who are already enrolled in another course, who can only access this exemption after having forfeited their previous career or after having changed to a different course. In this case no more than 20 CFU/ECTS will be recognised when changing course. The reference year is the year in which the current course starts.

Further exemptions may also be granted on the basis of specific agreements.

Where there are several conditions for exemption, the most favourable condition shall prevail.

#### **Art. 10 Exemption from all-inclusive fee for care leavers**

*Care leavers* enrolled at the University in their first academic year are exempt from the payment of the all-inclusive fee and therefore are only required to pay stamp duty and regional tax. Care leavers are those who, pursuant to Law no. 205/2017, "on reaching the age of 18 years, live outside the family of origin on the basis of a decision of judicial authority". In the event of registering in years subsequent to the first, for a number of academic years less than or equal to the normal duration of the course of study plus one, the exemption is only granted to those who meet the merit requirements set out in Art. 9.2.b.

#### **Art. 11 Reduction of the all-inclusive fee**

1. For members of a household whose ISEE certificate is between €25,000.00 and €30,000.00 and who meet the following requirements:

- A. they have been students at the Università Politecnica delle Marche for a number of academic years which is less than or equal to the normal course duration plus one;
- B. second year students who have achieved at least 10 university credits (CFU/ECTS) by 10th August of their first year. Students registered in academic years subsequent to the second year, who have achieved at least 25 credits during the 12 month period prior to 10th August preceding their registration. For part-time registration, the necessary credits are reduced to 5 and 12 respectively. For 3rd year students registered in the Medicine and Surgery course, it is sufficient to have acquired 18 credits in the twelve months prior to August 10th preceding the relative registration; the all-inclusive fee cannot exceed 7% of the share of ISEE in excess of €13,000,00. This amount will be further reduced in accordance with Annex C.

2. For members of a household whose ISEE certificate is less than €30,000.00 and who meet the requirement in point (B) but not in point (A), the fee cannot exceed that determined by the penultimate period of the preceding sub-paragraph plus 50%, with a minimum value of €200.

### **Art. 12 Reduction of the all-inclusive fee for certain categories**

The following reductions are foreseen:

1. 50% of the all-inclusive fee, determined in accordance with Art. 3, and exemption from the regional tax for those in the first year “fuori corso” (students who have not completed all exams foreseen in an academic year are considered “fuori corso”, or behind schedule), beneficiaries or those eligible for the six-monthly regional scholarship (ERDIS).
2. 10% of the contribution to those within the same family household who are simultaneously enrolled with other brothers or sisters at the Università Politecnica delle Marche in degree courses and master’s degree courses, including single-cycle courses. This benefit is also granted to members descending from the same family line, if enrolled at the same time in any course at the University;
3. 5% of the contribution to those within family household who are simultaneously enrolled in bachelor’s degree and master’s degree courses, including single-cycle courses, with other brothers or sisters, at the Università Politecnica delle Marche or at one of the following Universities in the Marche region that the University has a specific agreement with: University of Macerata, University of Camerino and University of Urbino “Carlo Bo”. This benefit is also granted to members of the same family line who are enrolled in one of the other universities in the Marche region.
4. 10% for students belonging to a household with a deceased parent (orphan student).

Further exemptions may also be granted on the basis of specific agreements with other universities and subject to reciprocity.

### **Art. 12 bis Carlo Urbani Fund**

The Carlo Urbani Fund, set up by Deliberation No. 266 dated 21/04/2020, is intended for students in situations of personal and/or economic difficulty, and who therefore may request a reduction of the all-inclusive contribution if they have an ISEE of less than € 30,000 and a declaration attesting to such difficulties. The allocation of the reduction will be assessed by Carlo Urbani Fund Committee.

### **Art. 13 Application of minimum fee**

For students registered in bachelor's degree and master's degree courses in the following situations, the minimum fee (€240) adjusted in line with the course coefficient is payable, regardless of their financial situation:

1. students doing one year national voluntary civil service without interrupting their studies (this benefit is only for one academic year, whilst doing this service);
2. pregnant students with supporting documentation who do not interrupt their studies (this benefit is only for the year in which the child is born, subject to the presentation of a medical certificate);
3. students with duly certified situations of serious and prolonged illness, without the situation interrupting their studies (the intervention will be limited only to the year or years in which the illness persists, subject to the presentation of a medical certificate);
4. those with invalidity less than 66% and more than 45%. In this case, the intervention shall be limited to a maximum duration not exceeding three times the legal duration of the course for each level;
5. workers and students who are dependants, with at least one parent who is unemployed, furloughed, or in receipt of an ordinary or special redundancy fund or in derogation. This status must persist for at least six months, even if not continuous, within the 12 months preceding the deadline for submitting the ISEE certificate and must be proved by means of a declaration in lieu of affidavit issued pursuant to Art. 47 of Presidential Decree 445/2000;
6. students affected by natural calamity: The Chancellor will assess the significance of the damage by type and degree. Each case is examined individually;
7. *Caregivers*, i.e. students who can provide supporting documents to show they take daily care of a sick family member (spouse, family member or similar up to second degree) who is insufficient or in any case in need of long-term help and unable to take care of themselves.

The benefits provided for in points 5, 6 and 7 are only for students with an ISEE certificate not exceeding the maximum limit of €30,000.

### **Art. 14 Tuition fee refund in the event of graduation**

Students who meet both requirements:

- obtaining all CFUs (University Educational Credits) for admission to the final examination by 28th February of each year of reference;
  - passing the final examination by the first possible session in their final academic year
- are entitled to reimbursement of payments in excess of the minimum fee.

### **Art. 15 Withdrawal of benefits and exemptions**

The University will withdraw the benefits granted should a situation of non-conformity come to light further to checks carried out on the declarations made.

Students who obtain the ERDIS scholarship, and who forfeit or in any way lose the right to such a scholarship, following a withdrawal order issued by ERDIS itself, must pay the regional fee and the all-inclusive fee pursuant to Art. 3.

### **Art. 16 - Refund methods**

Fees will only be reimbursed as follows:

- payment into a current account held in the name of the student (or a joint account held in their name);
- payment into a prepaid card in the student's name (with an associated IBAN).

It is the student's responsibility to indicate their bank details (IBAN code) in the Personal Area of Esse3 and keep them up to date. The University is in no way liable for failure to reimburse if the student has provided incorrect reimbursement data in their personal area.

No reimbursement will be made for sums under €12.00 (limit established as per Art. 1, paragraph 137 of Law no. 266 dated 23/12/2005 for taxes or additional fees resulting from tax returns and to which reference is made).

### **Art. 17 PhD programmes**

PhD students are exempt from the payment of all-inclusive fees. Therefore, only stamp duty and regional tax for the right to university education are due.

Exemption from paying the regional tax applies and therefore only stamp duty is due for students who have been recognized as having a handicap as per Art. 3 paragraph 1, of Law 104/1992, or a recognized invalidity equal to or greater than 66%, as established by art 9 paragraph 2 of legislative Decree 68/2012.

### **Art. 18 - Specialisation Schools**

The annual fee for enrolling in specialisation schools is €1,256.00, in addition to the stamp duty and the regional tax for the right to university education.

This amount is payable in two installments: the first, €496, at the time of enrollment/no later than the start date of the training year. The second, €916, is due no later than 6 months after the start of the training year.

Exemption from paying the regional tax applies and therefore only stamp duty is due for students who have been recognized as having a handicap as per Art. 3 paragraph 1, of Law 104/1992, or a recognized invalidity equal to or greater than 66%, as established by art 9 paragraph 2 of legislative Decree 68/2012.

### **Art. 19 Postgraduate courses and master's-courses**

The fee payable for enrolling in level I and II Master's degree courses and postgraduate courses is determined by the individual calls for application.

### **Art. 20 Surcharges due for late payment**

Any person who makes a payment later than the due date or who does not comply with the deadlines set out in this Regulation shall be liable to pay a surcharge as defined in Annex A.

### **Art. 21 Other charges**

Additional charges shall be applied for services provided on request, as defined in Annex B.

### **Art. 22 Final provisions**

In so far as not provided for in this Regulation, the relevant laws in force shall apply.

### **Annex C - Phased reduction of the annual all-inclusive fee with respect to the maximum amount due**

The maximum all-inclusive fee, in the cases provided for in Article 11, is reduced gradually according to the following algorithm and with the variables described in the table below, **where x** is the equivalent income (ISEE):

- If  $i=1$  the reduction coefficient is 0.8
- if  $i=2, 3$  and  $4$ , the formula used is:

$$a_{i-1} - [(x - X^{\min}_i) * (a_{i-1} - a_i) / (X^{\max}_i - X^{\min}_i)]$$
